Aloha Parents, Guardians, and Students,

The purpose of this communication is to inform you that **Kamaile Academy's Return to Campus Plan will be delayed as a result of the recent spike in COVID positivity rates and case counts. The new start date for additional students returning to campus will be pushed back to at least January 25th.** We recognize this may cause hardship and additional stress for many of our families and students. We apologize for this inconvenience, however, safety for all remains our top priority at this time.

Phase 1: Phase 1 will continue until at least January 25th. Most students will continue with Distance Learning.

- We will continue to offer blended (virtual and face-to-face learning) opportunities for students that have unique individual learning needs.
- Students who utilized the Learning Lab in Semester 1 and/or during the week of January 5th will shift to Distance Learning. Students who did not have internet access should now be able to attend classes virtually as MiFi devices were issued before the break. If for some reason your family did not receive a MiFi device and you are without internet access at home, please contact us at 697-7110 x126 or info@kamaile.org.

***** Phase 2: Phase 2 will begin no earlier than January 25th.**

- Students whose families have requested Blended Learning will return to campus two days per week (on or after January 25th). This is after the reported number of COVID cases indicate that it is safe to return more students to campus. All remaining students will continue with distance learning.
- Families that selected blended learning options have already been assigned days for your student(s) to be on campus. These days will remain the same when Phase 2 begins.

*** Should the COVID positivity rate/case counts continue to be elevated, then we will need to continue to delay the start of Phase 2.
