In honor of Mahina 'Ōlelo Hawai'i (Hawaiian Language Month) established in 2012, here are some resources for your 'ohana to learn and practice Hawaiian language, or participate in events across the state.

Click on the [Hawai'i State Public Library System](#) to access their resources: check out an ukulele, borrow music CDs (including live concerts) or performance and documentary DVDs, and learn a Hawaiian Word of the Day.

Have you heard of WORDLE? You can now play a Hawaiian language version! You read correctly, the viral word game is now on <http://hulihua.net> and no downloading is needed to play. You can be challenged to solve a new 5-letter word every day. After guessing an initial word, the game tells you if you guessed letters correctly in the wrong spot (yellow) or in the right spot (green). Try it out!
