



Kau ka Pe'a Morning & Afternoon Connections Program

KAPCS understands that some 'ohana need to drop off their elementary keiki early to school, while some may need to pick up their keiki a little later than 2:00 p.m. To support 'ohana, we are opening up registration for our **Morning and Afternoon Connections Program** for haumāna (students) in kindergarten through 6th grade. Under the umbrella of Kau ka Pe'a, Morning & Afternoon Connections provides an engaging space to start and end each school day.

This is different than our Kau ka Pe'a Enrichment program, which will start later in August, held on Tuesdays and Thursdays only. There will be separate registration forms for that.

- o Ohana can register for just the morning, just the afternoon, or both, by filling out this google form.
- o Registration is required for any haumāna arriving to campus before 6:45 a.m., and leaving campus later than 2:00 p.m.
- o Families will be contacted via email prior to the official start date regarding acceptance and/or waitlist.
- o Registration will be open until Friday, 8/5.
- o Times and dates are subject to change.
- o Programs are FREE OF CHARGE.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- o Parents or Guardians MUST provide proof of one of the following:
- o Employment during program hours, or
- o Attending school (i.e. college/university, training program): or
- o Kau ka Pe'a or Kamaile Academy Employee

**Program staff may ask anytime during the program for proof of eligibility requirements.*

Haumāna in the program MUST:

- o Follow the Student Handbook during the program
- o Follow COVID-19 protocol (ex: if you're sick, stay home)
- o Be in grades K-6 ONLY
