

Under the umbrella of Kau ka Pe'a, our Kamaile Academy PCS Morning & Afternoon Connections Program provides an engaging space for students to start and end each school day when a slightly earlier campus arrival time and/or slightly later 'ohana pick-up time is needed. Legal parents/guardians must provide required documentation to be eligible for the program.
