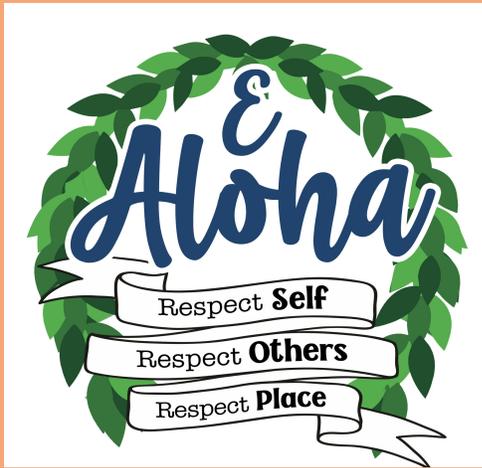

Showing E Aloha by Supporting Strong Attendance

As caregivers, we show E Aloha when we nurture and guide keiki in their academic, social, emotional, and physical development. Showing up to school on time every day is extremely important to that development, and chronically missing school can have a lasting negative impact.

Missing 10% of school (1 or 2 days every few weeks) can make it harder to:

- Gain early reading and math skills
- Build relationships
- Develop good attendance habits

Attendance Works has some suggestions to make the morning routine easier so we can get to school on time every day:

- Set a regular bedtime and morning routine.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Share ideas with other parents for getting to school on time.

Principal's Message

Aloha e ka 'ohana Kamaile,

Shout out to all of our Kamaile haumāna and staff for a strong start to the school year. I want to extend a special mahalo to all of our 'ohana that were able to attend our Open House on Thursday, August 18th. It was our first in-person event since the start of the pandemic and it felt incredible to see so many of you back on campus. We had over 400 classroom visits and gave out nearly as many servings of shave ice served by our Friends of Kamaile Parent Teacher Organization!

By this point in the school year, classrooms are taking deep dives into the curriculum and all haumāna are finishing up their i-Ready diagnostic assessments. I want to encourage all 'ohana to have engaging conversations in the evenings with your keiki about school tasks, activities, and other aspects of the school day. Ask them what excites them at school, what they are learning about, and what goals they have set. Goals that are set, supported, monitored, and talked about regularly are goals that are met.

Lastly, we want to stress the importance of coming to school on time every day. Our attendance goal for Kamaile this year is to have 90% of our students at school every day! Please strive for five and have your keiki in school five days a week. Classrooms who hit this 90% target each week will earn a celebration for all haumāna in the class. Individuals with perfect attendance will also be invited to participate in VIP Lunches at the end of each month, and will earn a special treat.

We look forward to working closely with our haumāna and 'ohana as we navigate our school towards success and we thank you in advance for your continued support. 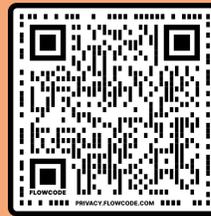
