# State Testing Continues

All students in grades 3-8 and 11 will take the Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA) in English Language Arts and Math and all students in grades 5 and 8 will take the Hawai'i State Science Assessments. Testing will begin in March and run through May. Your child will take the assessments on different days during the school year. We will inform you of the specific dates before your child takes each assessment. You can support testing by:

- Making sure your child gets plenty of rest the night before the test.
- Making sure your child eats breakfast either at home or at school (free breakfast service starts at 6:45 a.m.)
- Encouraging your child to try their best on the test!
